

B&T Midsummer Ale (3.5%)

A straw coloured quaffing ale for the hot (?) summer weather.

Beartown Kodiak Gold (4.0%)

Well balanced, straw coloured and very drinkable with citrus fruit and hops aroma and sharper, bitter, clean aftertaste.

Broughton Summer Ale (3.5%)

A single malt ale, hopped to give a clean aftertaste. A great Summer drink.

Castle Rock Harvest Pale (3.8%)

Using gently kilned malt with a wonderful blend of American hops are added during the brewing process gives this pale beer beautiful poise. The hops are very noticeable and lead to a crisp aftertaste.

Castle Rock Hemlock (4.0%)

Mid strength, full flavoured bitter with fruity notes on the palate with a smack of hops on the finish.

Conwy Sun Dance (4.0%)

"Dawns Haul" in Welsh. A refreshing summer ale with strong citrus notes.

Dark Star Hophead (3.8%)

Light straw coloured bitter with fully hoppy aroma and clean crisp bitterness from Cascade hops.

Dark Star Hylder Blonde (4.2%)

A delicate and lightly hopped beer with the fresh fruitiness of elderflowers.

Dent Sunny Wether (4.5%)

Brewed solely with Cluster hops, which give this light coloured bitter a spicy and aromatic aroma, and a distinctive bitterness.

Downton Quadhop (3.9%)

As the name implies, this is a beer brewed using four varieties of hops :- East Kent Goldings, Pioneer, Challenger, Styrian Goldings. A golden coloured beer with the full range of hop flavours and aromas.

Exe Valley Devon Summer (3.9%)

A refreshing straw coloured bitter brewed with Devon malt and English hops.

High House Farm Sundancer (3.6%)

A light golden thirst quenching beer for the those long hot summer days. Named after High House Farm's piebald pony Sunny!

Houston Blonde Bombshell (4.0%)

This gold coloured ale is smooth and easy drinking with a fresh hop aroma, well rounded maltiness and a delicate fruit aftertaste.

Leeds Samba (3.7%)

A hugely drinkable blonde beer. Using malts more usually associated with lager this pale brew is delicate and fruity whilst retaining a clean finish.

Little Valley Withens IPA (3.9%)

Light and bright this IPA uses refreshing floral hops and hints of spice, orange and citrus giving a smooth finish.

Morque Summer Tyne (3.6%)

A very pale, lager style beer, to be drunk on hot nights. Complex hop aroma. Be warned, easy to drink!

Oakham Inferno (4.0%)

This light igniting ale flickers complex fruits across your tongue leaving a dry fruity bitter finish smothering your thirst.

Pictish Brewers Gold (3.8%)

A refreshing, thirst quenching pale golden session beer. Malty undertones and a powerful spicy hop aroma combine to produce a dangerously moreish beer.

Prospect Silver Tally (3.7%)

A very pale beer with citrus aromas and a full hop flavour.

Robinsons Dizzy Blonde (3.8%)

Straw coloured Summer ale with distinctive herbal or perfume like hop aroma. This light refreshing beer has a clean zesty hop dominated palate complimented by a crisp dry finish.

Saltire Sundowner (3.8%)

A light refreshing bitter with citrus hops and a hint of orange.

Vale Hadda's Summer Glory (4.0%)

Amber coloured - excellent hop aroma.

Williams Brothers Roisin (4.2%)

A light pink coloured beer, brewed with barley and rye malts, and European hops. At the final stage of our process we Infuse the beer with fresh Tayberries (a cross between raspberries and brambles) to give a subtle fruit flavour, and a refreshing, fruity, aroma.
